Rightly Dividing the Word of Truth  
2 Timothy 2:15

Welcome to Episode #017 of Way of the Bible podcast. Today we'll be discussing an application of a statement written to Timothy by the Apostle Paul in 2 Timothy 2:15. In context, Paul is instructing his young disciple Timothy on who to look out for among the flock and how to conduct himself in instances of hostile conflict concerning the gospel from within and exterior to the church.

Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

Example of putting something together before and after reading instructions.

Let's look at what marked packages come in the Box we call the Bible that need to be put into their place such that the truth is rightly divided. In future episodes we'll open these packages and start assembling them; not necessarily in the order they are presented today.

1. The six days of creation
2. Mankind in the time of innocence.
3. The fall of mankind and expulsion from the garden
4. The first death, Abel, and the significance
  - a. The grave or pit for mankind was opened
5. The lines of Seth and Cain
6. Enoch, Noah, and the flood
7. The tower of Babel
8. The calling of Abram and his descendants time in Egypt
9. The exodus from Egypt, Moses, and giving of the Law
10. The history of Israel under the Law
  - a. Judges, Kings, Kingdoms, Prophets, and Rebellion
11. The first coming of Messiah, Jesus Christ as Prophet
12. The mystery of Grace in the church age, Jesus Christ as Priest
13. The scattering of the Jews among the nations
14. The times of the gentiles and Daniel's 70 weeks

15. Jesus' aerial return for resurrection of righteous dead only and translation of the new testament believers (Rapture)
16. The Judgment seat of Christ for New Testament believers
17. Daniel's 70<sup>th</sup> week, Anti-Christ and the judgment of the Jews
18. The Marriage feast of the Lamb
19. Jesus' physical return to judge the nations
20. Thousand-year reign of Jesus Christ as King
21. The second resurrection of the dead and Great White Throne Judgment of the wicked
22. Renovation of the heavens and earth with fire
23. The new heavens and new earth

On our next episode #018, we're going back to Genesis to look more fully at the first six days of creation. What is presented in the text is not allegory or myth of how things came to be, but exactly details the orderly process Jesus used to create something very good in God's sight.
